



Summer Music Program 2020

Instrumental music lessons will be offered to children entering grades 5 - 9. This will provide an opportunity for children to begin an instrument or continue to develop their musical abilities during the summer months. The summer music lessons will consist of five levels.

- Level 0: Beginners
- Level I: One year of experience
- Level II Two years of experience
- Level III: Three years of experience
- Level IV: Four years of experience

Every student will receive three half-hour lessons each week beginning Tuesday, July 7th and ending Thursday, July 30th. The lessons will take place on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday mornings scheduled every half hour between 7:00 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. for a total of 12 lessons. Instrumental lessons are limited to the instruments currently offered during the regular school year.

- Students with two or more years of experience may be grouped in small performance-based ensembles.
- Fourth grade students should check with their school's instrumental music teacher to find out what instrument they will be playing in September 2020.
- Instruments that are provided by the district **MUST** be obtained from the school music department that your child will be attending in September 2020. **Parents are responsible for requesting and making arrangements to pick up the instrument before the last day of school.**
- Confirmations will be e-mailed mid-June. Please contact **summer@friendsofmusicofsmithtown.org** if you do not receive an e-mailed confirmation by June 22nd. It is the parent's responsibility to see that their child is present on the first day of class. No credit/refund will be given.
